Directions

FROM THE NORTH

Leave the M1 motorway at Junction 33.

Travel up the slip road and turn right off the roundabout onto the Sheffield Parkway.

From the Sheffield Parkway, take the third exit and at the small roundabout go straight across, following the signs for the ring road.

At the next roundabout, with Granada Service Station on your left, turn left onto Prince of Wales Road (A6102). Travel to the top of Prince of Wales Road to where the tram lines start, following the A6102 (this is also sign posted Chesterfield).

Travelling along this road you will encounter 3 roundabouts, the third of which is a large roundabout with The Norton public house/restaurant on your right. Turn left at this roundabout onto the dual carriageway (Sheffield Moat House Hotel is on your left).

At the next roundabout go straight across, there is a public house called Bowshaw Inn on your right, following the signs for Dronfield.

Drive until you reach the Coach and Horses public house on your right, then take your next right turn into Stubley Hollow. Drive up the hill, Bootleggers night club/wine bar is on your right, go under the bridge, then take your next left turn into Stubley Lane.

Gunstones Bakery is approximately 200 yards further down this road on your right.

FROM THE SOUTH

Leave the M1 motorway at Junction 29, and following the signs for Chesterfield drive towards Chesterfield down the dual carriageway until you reach a large roundabout (Brian Donkins Foundry is on the left of this roundabout).

Turn right at the roundabout and take the A61 sign posted Sheffield.

From here you will drive through two roundabouts, the second of which is a large roundabout with a cycle shop on your right.

Go across this roundabout, following the A61 Dronfield Bypass to Sheffield.

Once you are on this bypass, ignore the first exit which is sign posted Dronfield and Unstone.

Drive to the end of this bypass until you reach a roundabout. Turn right at this roundabout, following the signs for Dronfield. As you leave the roundabout, you will see the Bowshaw Inn public house on your right.

Drive until you reach the Coach & Horses public house on your right, then take your next right turn into Stubley Hollow. Drive up the hill, Bootleggers night club is on your right, go under the bridge, then take your next left turn into Stubley Lane.

Gunstones Bakery is approximately 200 yards further down this road on your right.
